

A Message from our Director

Every week when I go to Lansdale to get the mail I think about Sam and how much I miss him. I used to visit him weekly and we would catch up on ministry things and the pro-life movement. He would have been appalled to see the recent passing of the abortion bill in the state of New York.

It is incomprehensible to me that not only are they attempting to justify late term abortions but they have gone so far as to celebrate them. It's sickening. The history of abortion in our country dates back to January 22, 1973 when two cases were decided on in the highest court of our land. The first one is the well known Roe v Wade which legalized abortion until the unborn baby was viable (able to live outside the womb). What most people don't realize, or aren't aware of , is the second decision called Doe v Bolton which removed all restrictions on abortion (including viability of the baby) if there was any health concern. They defined health to include, "physical, emotional, psychological, familial and age." The basic effect was to legalize (federally) abortion until the day of birth in all 50 states. However, each state was given the right to determine at what gestational age they would allow abortions. New York has begun a domino effect in which a few states have decided they are going to push the late term abortion allowance. We can only pray that the cases of late term abortion remain very low.

We here at Morning Star Maternity Home will continue to light a candle in a dark world by providing an alternative to abortion. We will continue to provide shelter, support, and guidance to the young women who have chosen life. With your help and prayers we have been able to do this for the past 32 years. Your prayers and support have been invaluable. Thank you from the bottom of our hearts!
